The annual Farm Safety Day at Stampede Park is a learning opportunity focused on developing and enhancing awareness and prevention skills to help rural youth and their families stay safe. The Calgary Stampede, supported by AltaLink, is pleased to offer this important educational opportunity to Alberta students in Grades 6 to 9.

This one-day program is FREE and space is limited, so please register early. Please also note that bus funding is available to schools that require assistance.

- To ensure the safety and comfort of our visitors, there are a maximum number of visitors permitted in AltaLink Hall at any given time. **Pre-registration is mandatory** for all classes.
- Registration forms are processed on a first come, first served basis.
- We ask that each student have a Photo/Video Release Permission Form, signed by a parent or guardian. If this is not possible please contact us, details are listed below.
- Confirmation of participation will be emailed to teachers within 7 days of receiving their registration form.
- Registered schools must arrange their own bus transportation to and from Calgary Stampede Park. We request that schools requiring bus funding email or fax us a copy of the bussing invoice (see contact info below) in order to receive reimbursement.
- There will be a 30-minute lunch break for teachers and students during Farm Safety Day.
 As there is limited food service available on-site, students and teachers are encouraged to
 bring a bagged lunch. The concession in the building will be open if required with a limited
 selection.
