LOST KIDS WRIST BANDS This year, we are providing free Lost Kids wrist bands to all students attending Aggie Days. These wrist bands will be given to you ahead of time. Please take just a couple of minutes to fill them in before you being your field trip. On the Line provided please place the Cell Phone Number of the contact person that will be at Aggie Days so if you were to get separated we can easily contact you and get everyone back together again.



Make sure that each student has a Wrist Band on **<u>BEFORE</u>** they exit the busses to maximize the time you get to spend with us.



PEOPLE IN RED VESTS CAN HELP All Aggie Days Committee Members will be wearing these RED vests. Please tell your students that if they are having a problem to look for a person in a red vest. Aggie Days Committee Members will be able to make contact with our office, Medical Staff or Emergency Dispatch and they have a detailed plan in place to make our event as fun and safe as possible.

LOST KIDS AND MEDICAL LOCATION: After you exit your bus, you will walk between the Ag Barn and the Western Event Centre. The first set of doors you see on your Left (Nutrien Western Events Center) will have a flashing orange light. We ask that you tell your students and Supervisors that this is where we have our Lost Kids Office, Medical Services and our Aggie Days office. From this location, we can access all Stampede services and this will be where you will come to pick up a lost child unless told otherwise when you are contacted by phone.





CONTACT PERSON MUST HAVE THEIR CELL PHONE ON Cell Phones are only helpful to our safety team if they are turned on and charged, so please make sure they are. Thank-you!

TAKE A PICTURE OF YOUR STUDENTS A great way to identify a student, should they become separated from you, is to take their picture the day of the field trip so you can show the Red Vest Volunteer and/or CS Security exactly what that child looks like
